

ORDINANCE NO. 95-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE EQUIPMENT SERVICE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF CAPITAL PURCHASE IN THE FORM OF MOTOR VEHICLE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has located a new motor vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has heretofore budgeted funds for the purpose of equipment purchases; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Commission of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from the Equipment Service Fund Investments, Two Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Five dollars (\$2,795), for the purpose of making a capital purchase of a new motor vehicle.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from the Equipment Service Fund Investments, Two Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Five dollars (\$2,795), for the purpose of making a capital purchase of a new motor vehicle.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

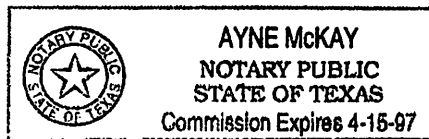

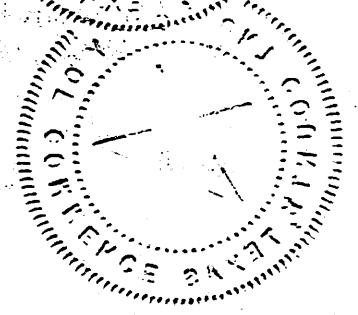
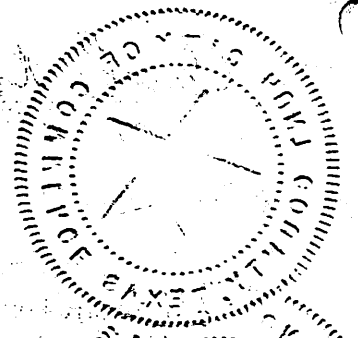
