

ORDINANCE NO. 95-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM EXISTING ACCOUNTS FOR PROVISION OF LEGAL SERVICES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, it has been projected that the City of Commerce will need an additional Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) for legal fees for Fiscal Year 1994-1995; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted funds for this additional amount of legal fees; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Commission of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from the following existing funds: Accts. 115-43012 and 130-44019; Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000), for the purpose of making provision of legal services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from the following existing funds: Accts. 115-43012 and 130-44019; Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000), for the purpose of making provision of legal services.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

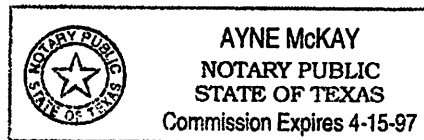

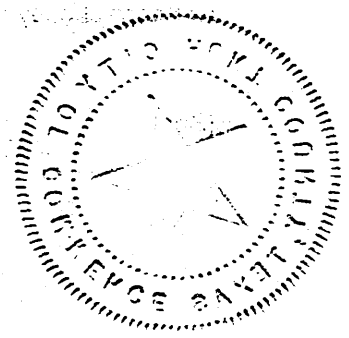
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
