

**ORDINANCE NO. 95-4**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING TRIBUNAL AND ADMINISTRATOR FOR JUNK VEHICLE REMOVAL; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:**

**WHEREAS,** Pursuant to VACS Article 4477-9a Section 5.09(e) the Municipal Court of the City of Commerce is designated as the tribunal for hearings on the removal of junk vehicles. The Municipal Judge of the City of Commerce is authorized and directed to perform the duties commensurate with the provisions of said VACS Article 4477-9a relating to the holdings of hearings in connection with said statute.

**WHEREAS,** Pursuant to VACS Article 4477-9a Section 5.09(h) the City Inspector of the City of Commerce is appointed to administer the procedures of VACS Article 4477-9a relating to junk vehicles within the City of Commerce. The City Inspector of the City of Commerce is authorized and directed to perform the duties commensurate with the provisions of VACS Article 4477-9a relating to administering the procedures for removal of junk vehicles.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED,** and it is hereby ordained that the Municipal Court of the City of Commerce is designated as the tribunal for hearings on the removal of junk vehicles, and the City Inspector of the City of Commerce is appointed to administer the procedures of VACS Article 4477-9a relating to junk vehicles within the City of Commerce.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

**SECTION 1:** If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

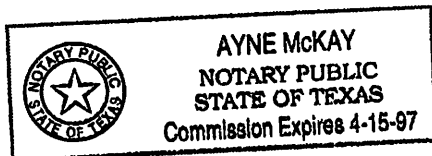
