

ORDINANCE NO. 95-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE BE AMENDED BY REVISING THE TRAFFIC NO-PARKING MAP ADOPTED IN PARAGRAPH 3 OF SECTION 25-112 OF SAID CODE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1:

WHEREAS, that the Traffic No-Parking Map adopted in Paragraph 3 of Section 25-112 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce, Texas, be amended to include the following No-Parking area:

Designate a No-Parking Zone in the 2000-2400 blocks of Monroe Street, from Greenville Street to Aldridge Street on both sides of Monroe Street, same being reflected on plat attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim;

With the following exemption: During church hours of operation, that parking be allowed on the west side of Monroe Street in the 2200 and 2300 block only 100 ft. from Cooper Street, same being reflected on plat attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim;

SECTION II:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$200.00.

SECTION III:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION IV:

If any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this Ordinance.

SECTION V: That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Commerce, Texas, and the inhabitants thereof; therefore, all rules and regulations providing for the reading of ordinances more than one time or on more than one occasion be and the same are hereby suspended, and this Ordinance is passed and shall take effect as an emergency measure, and

shall be and remain in full force and effect as herein provided from and after its passage and approval.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
