

ORDINANCE NO. 95-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE 1995 CERTIFIED TAX ROLL FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE, PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The 1995 certified tax roll in the amount of \$166,513,664.00 is hereby approved and adopted.

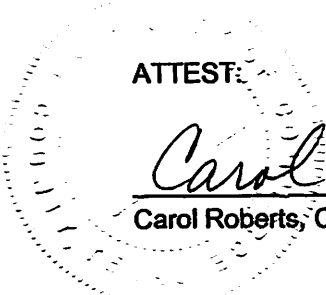
SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public, all rules and regulation requiring the reading of said ordinance more than one time and on more than one occasion are hereby suspended.

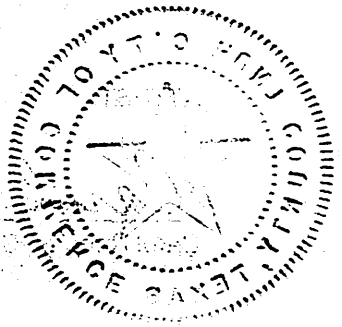

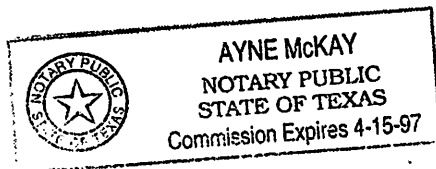
