

ORDINANCE NO. 95-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE 1995 EFFECTIVE TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE, PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the tax rate of \$100.00 valuation of the City of Commerce for tax year 1995 is as follows:

0.4646 for the purpose of maintenance and operation

0.0136 for the payment of principal and interest on debt for this city

0.4782 total tax rate

The tax collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of the City of Commerce, Texas, on this 5th day of September, 1995, and was executed in duplicate.

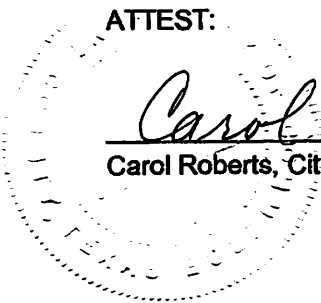
SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public, all rules and regulation requiring the reading of said ordinance more than one time and on more than one occasion are hereby suspended.

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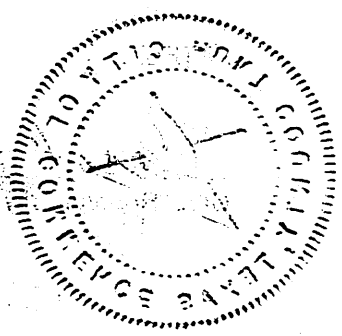

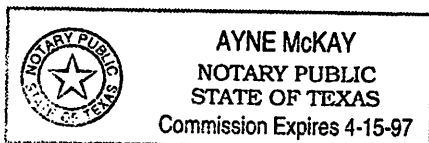

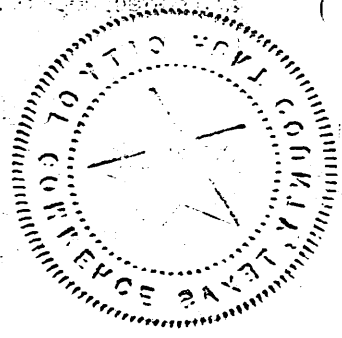
