

ORDINANCE NO. 95-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM EXISTING ACCOUNTS FOR PURCHASE OF ELECTRICAL SUPPLY PEDESTAL; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, it has become necessary that the City of Commerce will need to purchase an electrical supply pedestal for the downtown square of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted funds for the purchase of said pedestal; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from the following existing account: No. 01-15005; Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$738), for the purpose of purchasing electrical supply pedestal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from the following existing account: No. 01-15005; Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$738), for the purpose of purchasing electrical supply pedestal.

SECTION 1. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

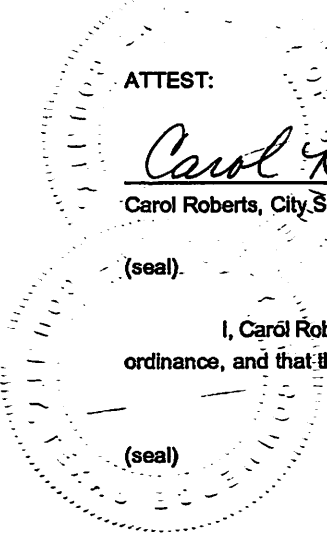
SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

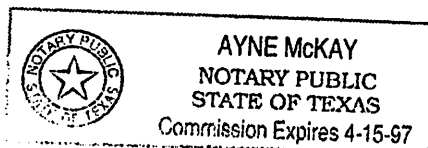
