

ORDINANCE 97-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, COMMERCE, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT A PORTION OF ELM, PRINCE, PINE AND ROSS STREETS BE RENAMED TO M.L. KING DRIVE; THAT A PORTION OF RAILROAD STREET BE RENAMED TO WILLIAMS DRIVE; THAT FAYE STREET BE RENAMED TO CHAMPION LANE; THAT A PORTION OF HIGH STREET BE RENAMED TO CHARLIE'S DRIVE; CONTAINING A REPEALING CLAUSE, A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, a request has been made by Ivory E. Moore, of Commerce, Texas, and;

WHEREAS, said individual has come before the City Council to request the aforementioned street name changes, and;

WHEREAS, after careful consideration by members of the City Council it has been deemed to be in the best interest and general welfare of the City of Commerce to rename said streets; name of said streets being changed from this day henceforth as shown herein and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim.

SECTION 1

Elm Street beginning at Park Street and ending at Prince Street be renamed to M.L. King Drive; Prince Street beginning at Elm Street and ending at Pine Street be renamed to M.L. King Drive; Pine Street beginning at Prince Street and ending at Ross Street be renamed to M.L. King Drive; Ross Street beginning at Pine Street and ending at Faye Street be renamed to M.L. King Drive; Ross Street beginning at Faye Street and ending at Prichard Road be renamed to M.L. King Drive.

SECTION 2

Railroad Street beginning at Buffington Street and ending at Faye Street be renamed to Williams Drive.

SECTION 3

Faye Street to be renamed to Champion Lane.

SECTION 4

High Street beginning at Ross Street and ending at Blackburn Street be renamed to Charlie's Drive.

WHEREAS, All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

WHEREAS, if any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance.

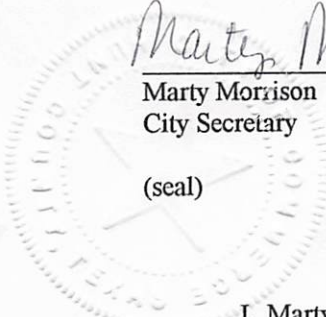

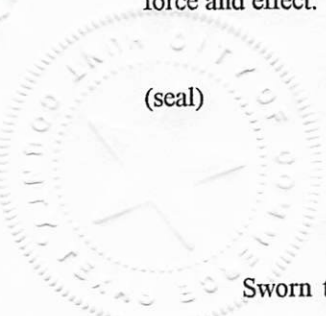

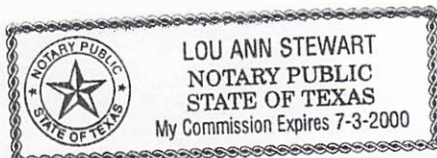
