

ORDINANCE NO. 97-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF UNANTICIPATED FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR THE PROVISION OF TRAINING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce has received \$1,921 from the State of Texas for training law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted funds for this training ; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it to be in the best interest and general welfare of the City that the unanticipated funds : One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$1921) be appropriated for Law Enforcement Training.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from unanticipated funds from the State: One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$1921) for the purpose of training under the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

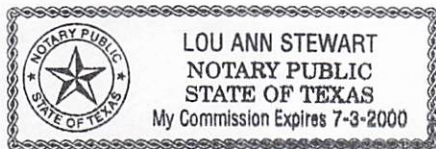

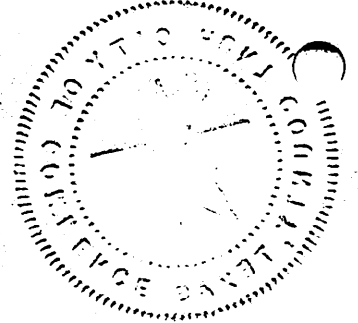
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
