

ORDINANCE NO. 97-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM AVAILABLE FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR PURCHASE OF A STAND-BY GENERATOR SYSTEM FOR THE ENHANCED 911 SYSTEM; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, it has been projected that the City of Commerce will need an additional \$9,200.00 for the purchase of a stand-by generator; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted funds for this additional generator; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from Funds Available; \$9,200.00, for the purpose of purchasing a stand-by generator for the Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from Funds Available; \$9,200.00, for the purpose of purchasing a stand-by generator for the Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.
