

ORDINANCE NO. 97-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT CD TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT BUDGET FOR PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce Volunteer Fire Department has requested additional equipment and will need an additional \$4,00.00 for the purchase of said equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted funds in the Fire Department budget for this equipment; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from the following account: Volunteer Fire Department CD; \$4,00.00, for the purpose of purchasing said equipment for the Volunteer Fire Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from the following account: Volunteer Fire Department CD; \$4,00.00, for the purpose of purchasing said equipment for the Volunteer Fire Department.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.
