

ORDINANCE NO. 97-15

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF V.T.C.A. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CODE SECTION 109.33 IN ITS ENTIRETY AS AMENDED BY THE 74TH TEXAS LEGISLATURE CHAPTER 260, SECTION 7, EFFECTIVE MAY 30, 1995 CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Commerce Independent School District has requested the Governing Body of the City of Commerce to extend the distance and measurement where alcoholic beverages may be sold. Reference is made thereto for all purposes, and

WHEREAS the City Council after careful review of the ordinance of the City of Commerce relating to alcoholic beverages in particular Section 6-3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City of Commerce that such request be honored and to implement same as well as changing Section 6-3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce to conform to State law does hereby adopt V.T.C.A. Alcoholic Beverage Code Section 109.33 in its entirety as amended by the 74th Texas Legislature Chapter 260, Section 7, effective May 30, 1995.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Commerce, Commerce, Texas that V.T.C.A. Alcoholic Beverage Code Section 109.33 in its entirety as amended by the 74th Texas Legislature Chapter 260, Section 7, effective May 30, 1995 reference is made thereto for all purposes be adopted and is hereby adopted.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. Whereas an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public, all rules and regulations requiring the reading of ordinance more than one time and on more than one occasion are hereby suspended.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval.

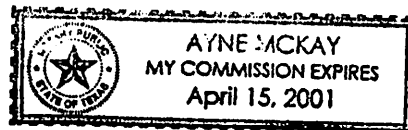
