

ORDINANCE NO. 97-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM AVAILABLE FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will receive \$18,461.00 for the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted these funds; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be funds appropriated into the Revenue Account in the amount of \$18,461.00 for the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be funds appropriated into the Expense Account in the amount of \$18,461.00.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

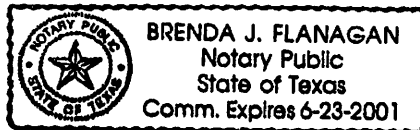
