

ORDINANCE NO. 98-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING ENTRANCE FEE RATES FOR CITY OF COMMERCE BASKET BALL GAMES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board recommends charging an admission fee into City of Commerce Basket Ball games; and

WHEREAS, the fee will be \$1.00 per person, school age and up; and

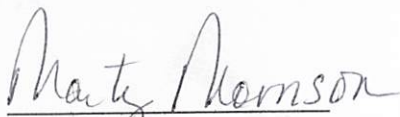
WHEREAS, players in uniform will be admitted free along with coaches and assistant coaches;
and

WHEREAS, this will be a one time per day fee; if a person leaves, their hand will be marked for re-entrance.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval.

PASSED AND APPROVED at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, on this the 3rd day of February, 1998.

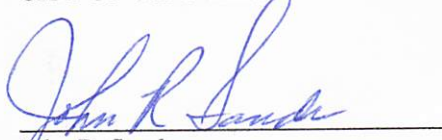

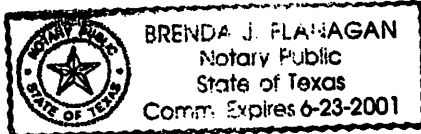
