

ORDINANCE NO. 98-9

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be adjusting salaries in the police, fire and community development departments in the amount of \$22,373.00; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from 140-46150; \$22,373.00 for the purpose of adjusting salaries of \$1,693.00 to community development, \$4,156.00 to the fire department and \$16,524.00 to the police department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from 140-46150; \$22,373.00, for the purpose of salary adjustments in the police, fire and community development departments.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

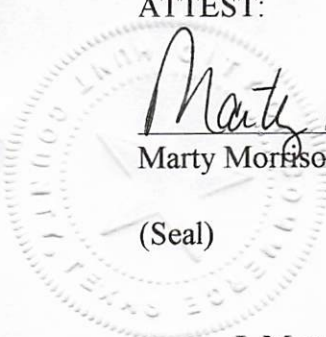
SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

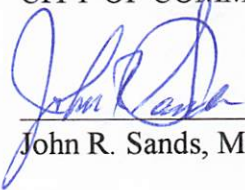

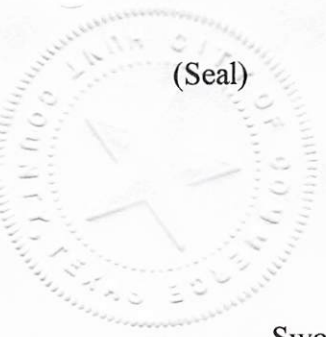

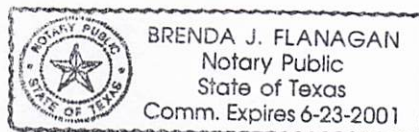

2. The second condition is that the person must be a resident of the United States.

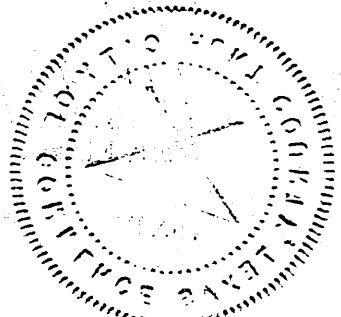
3. The third condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Army, Navy, or Air Force.

6. The sixth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Army Reserve.

7. The seventh condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Navy Reserve.



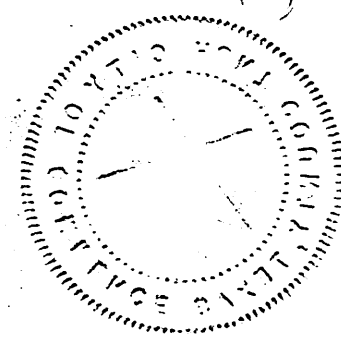
8. The eighth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Air Force Reserve.

9. The ninth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Marine Corps Reserve.

10. The tenth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Army National Guard.

11. The eleventh condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Navy National Guard.

12. The twelfth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Air Force National Guard.



13. The thirteenth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Marine Corps National Guard.

14. The fourteenth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Army National Guard.

15. The fifteenth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Navy National Guard.

16. The sixteenth condition is that the person must be a member of the United States Air Force National Guard.
