

ORDINANCE NO. 98-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE MONROE STREET PROJECT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will need an additional \$55,500.00 for reconstruction of 3,700 linear feet of Monroe Street; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted funds for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated from fund 140-46062 to Fund 130-43016; \$55,500.00, for the proposed Monroe Street Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated from Fund 140-46062 to Fund 130-43016; \$55,500.00, for the purpose of reconstructing 3,700 linear feet of Monroe Street.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

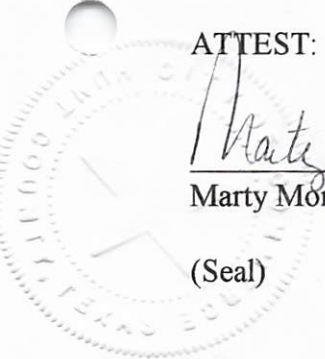
SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

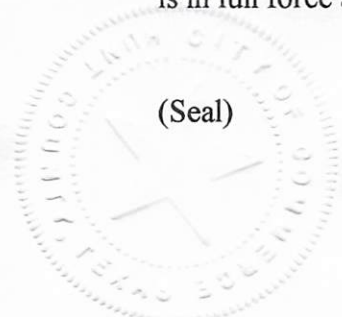

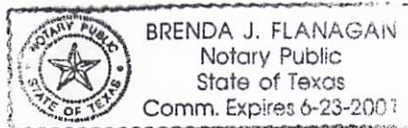
