

ORDINANCE 98-30

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, NAMING THE
COMMERCE JOURNAL AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE
CITY OF COMMERCE; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, on the 17th day of November, 1998, at 7:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following ordinance was adopted:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce, Texas has previously named the Commerce Journal as the Official Newspaper for the City of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce has since reviewed contract; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council deems it to be in the best interest and welfare of the City to select *The Commerce Journal* as the Official Newspaper for the City of Commerce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the City of Commerce hereby names *The Commerce Journal* to be the Official Newspaper for the City of Commerce.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this ordinance and all multiple readings of this ordinance are hereby waived; this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

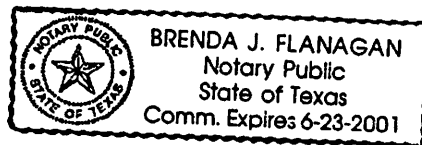
