

ORDINANCE NO. 98-31

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING STATE GRANT FUNDS FOR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will receive \$14,491.00 from the Local Law Enforcement Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has not budgeted for these funds; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that funds in the amount of \$14,491.00 be appropriated into fund 01—32150 for grant revenue.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

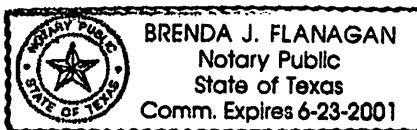
