

ORDINANCE NO. 99-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CABLE TELEVISION PERMIT OF PARAGON COMMUNICATIONS TO EXTEND PERMIT TERM BY NINETY DAYS ; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Paragon Cable entered into a Franchise Agreement with the Franchise Authority dated April 3, 1984, to own and operate a cable television system within the limits of the City of Commerce for the period from April 3, 1984 to April 3, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Franchise Authority and Paragon Cable each desire to enter into an Agreement extending the term of the franchise as set fourth herein; and

WHEREAS, the extension shall be without prejudice to the rights of either party under the Cable Act. For example, and by way of illustration and not limitation, any rights Franchisee has already asserted properly under 47 U.S.C. s 546(a) need not be asserted again, and are not affected by the amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, Franchise Authority and Paragon Cable agree as follows: The term of the Franchise is hereby extended from April 3, 1999 through July 2, 1999, subject to the same terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement dated April 3, 1984.

WHEREAS, all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

WHEREAS, if any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this Ordinance.

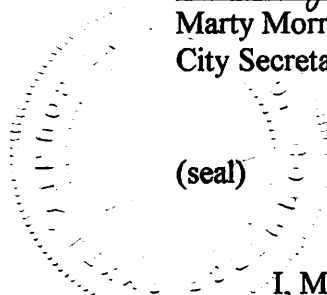

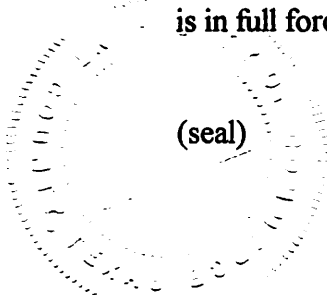
NOW, THEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

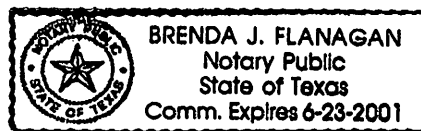

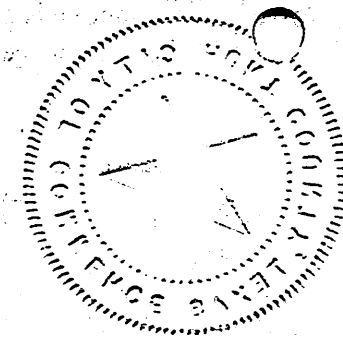
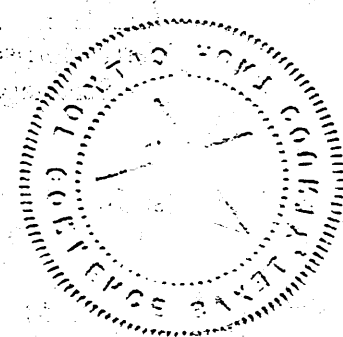
