

ORDINANCE NO. 99-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTER SOFTWARE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Commerce has agreed to purchase software which will enable the City of Commerce Administrative Services Department to become Y2-K compatible; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that funds not to exceed \$70,000 be appropriated from Water Fund Equity to Fund 200-50006 for payment.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

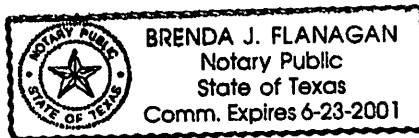
