

**ORDINANCE NO. 99-34**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR BIO-MONITORING; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Commerce will be adjusting Fund 300-43016 in the amount of \$23,372 for the purpose of bio-monitoring; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated \$23,372 to Fund 300-43016 for payment of said bio-monitoring test.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated \$23,372 for the purpose of bio-monitoring testing.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

**SECTION 1.** If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

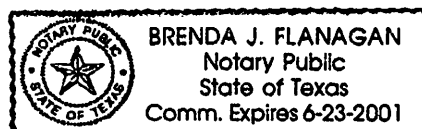
