

ORDINANCE #01-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE BE AMENDED BY RESCINDING ORDINANCE 95-24 BY REVISING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce hereby rescinds Ordinance 95-24, adopted November 7, 1995; and

WHEREAS Ordinance 95-24 designated a One-Way Traffic Zone in the 1400-1500 block of Pecan Street Northbound, effective during weekday hours of 7:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS Ordinance 95-24 also designated a 20 mph School Zone Speed Limit to be in the 1400-1500 block of Pecan Street and in the 1100-1200 block of Sycamore Street, effective during weekday hours of 7:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 95-24 designated a no-parking zone between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. during school days along the 1100-1200 block of Sycamore Street; and

WHEREAS, upon passage of said ordinance, the no-parking map will be amended by designating the 1100-1200 block of Sycamore Street as a no-parking zone.

WHEREAS the Commerce Independent School District no longer occupies the Middle School, the City Council hereby rescinds said Ordinance.

WHEREAS All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

WHEREAS If any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

WHEREAS This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

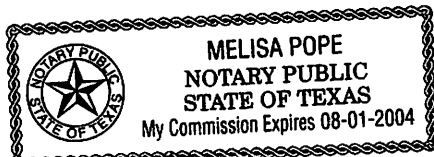
