

ORDINANCE NO. 01-07

AN ORDINANCE TERMINATING LOCAL DISASTER DECLARATION FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

EXECUTIVE ORDER BY MAYOR

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of January, 2001 the Mayor, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, Chapter 418, (the "Texas Disaster Act"), issued a proclamation declaring a local state of disaster for the City of Commerce resulting from a major ice storm and debris removal which began on December 26, 2000;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the proclamation of a local state of disaster have ceased to exist; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Disaster Act provides that a local state of disaster may be terminated by the governing body of the political subdivision or by executive order of the Mayor,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

1. The City Council, as the governing body of Commerce, Texas hereby terminates the proclamation of a local state of disaster described in the preamble above.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval.

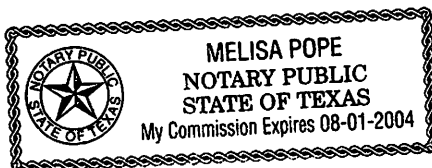
