

ORDINANCE 01-37

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING SECTION 66-55 OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

Section 66-55 of the Code of Ordinances entitled Animals, is hereby amended so that said section shall reflect the following additions and or changes:

Sec. 66-55 Animals.

It shall be unlawful to walk or ride any horse or other animal through any park. It shall be unlawful for any animal to be within the spectator area of any playing field while ball games are being played. The exception will be that of a service animal providing said service animal is leashed and in control of its owner. It shall be unlawful for any person to tether or pasture any cow, horse, mule or domestic animal in or upon any park or playground.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

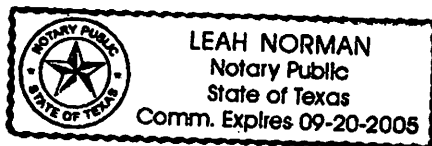
