

ORDINANCE 01-38

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING SECTION 22 OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING THE INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

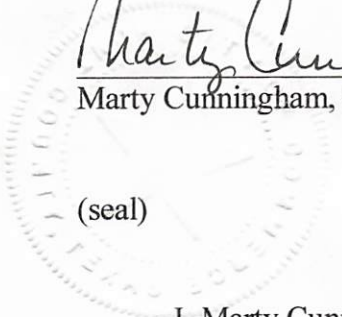
Section 22 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce, Texas is hereby amended by adopting the International Residential Code as set out in Subchapter G, Chapter 214 of the Local Government Code;

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

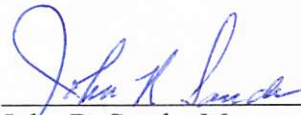
