

ORDINANCE NO. 02-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 01-17; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance 01-17 was adopted by the City Council on April 3, 2001, amending the Original Ordinance establishing the Beautification Commission; and

SECTION 2.

Ordinance 01-17 originally allowed placing thirteen (13) representative of the public at large on the Commission. Seven of whom will serve two year terms and six of whom will serve one year terms. Said Ordinance shall be amended by reducing the number of members appointed to serve on said Commission.

SECTION 3.

The City Council is now amending Ordinance 01-17 by only placing 9 representatives of the public at large on the Commission serving the initial terms appointed.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

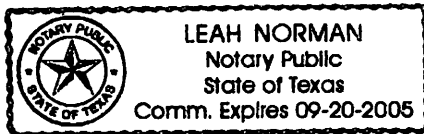
