

ORDINANCE 02-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, GRANTING A WAIVER TO ORDINANCE 42-2 ALLOWING FOR THE SALE OF FIREWORKS INSIDE WITH CITY LIMITS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 42-2 of the Code of Ordinances prohibits the sale of fireworks inside the city limits of Commerce, Texas;

SECTION 2. Due to the recent annexation of certain property located along Hwy 24/50 North, the City Council hereby grants an exception to section 42-2 of the Code of Ordinances to allow for the sale of fireworks by Mr. W Fireworks, Inc. for the period of sales ending July 4, 2002.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

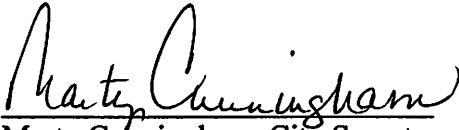
SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

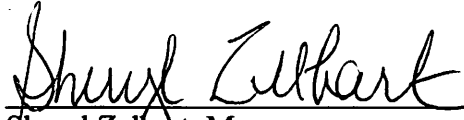
