

**ORDINANCE NO. 02-08**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 92-3 PERTAINING TO THE DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.**

Ordinance 92-3 was adopted by the City Council on March 10, 1992, adopting a Drought Contingency Plan; and

**SECTION 2.**

Ordinance 92-3 is hereby amended by the Commerce City Council said amended Drought Contingency Plan is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim;

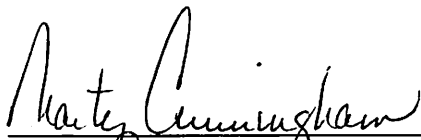

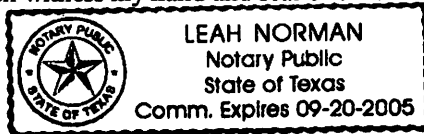
