

ORDINANCE 02-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, ADOPTING A NEW MASTER PLAN FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Commerce hereby adopts a new master plan for the city, which will in turn present a pattern of land uses for the development of future land use for said city.

SECTION 2. And whereas said master plan is on file in city secretary's office where it will become a permanent record.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

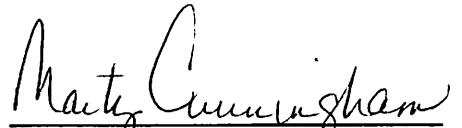
SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

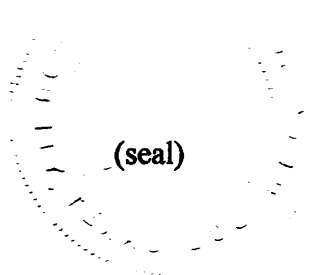

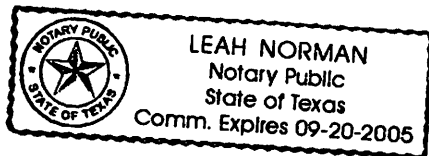
