

ORDINANCE NO. 02-27

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE GAFFORDS CHAPEL WATER LINE PROJECT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be appropriating funds from available funds in Water Excess R&R in the amount of \$110,000.00 for the sole purpose of installing an eight inch water line for Gaffords Chapel; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated \$110,000.00 from the available funds in Water Excess R&R to pay for said expenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that there be appropriated \$110,000.00 for the water line installation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

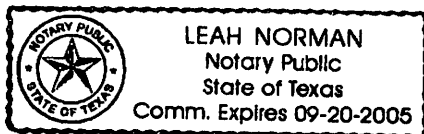
