

ORDINANCE NO. 03-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS INTO THE PERSONNEL BUDGET FOR DEPARTMENTS 110, 112 AND 200; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be appropriating funds in the amount of \$19,874.00 into Department 110; \$9,475.00 into Department 112; \$4,550.00 into Department 200 for the purpose of replacing funds into the personnel budget; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated \$19,874 into Department 110; \$9,475.00 into Department 112 and \$4,550.00 into Department 200; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 00-52

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS INTO THE PERSONNEL BUDGET FOR DEPARTMENT 111 AND 100 REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be appropriating funds in the amount of \$19,874.00 into Department 111, \$24,530.00 into Department 100 for the purpose of replacing funds into the personnel budget, and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated \$19,874 into Department 111, \$24,530.00 into Department 100, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That no controversy exists necessitating the suspension of any rule regarding multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

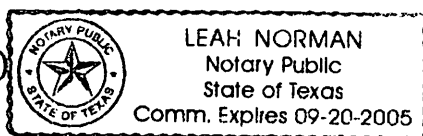
