

ORDINANCE 03-30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING ARTICLE II SECTION 58 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

Article II, Section 58 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce, Texas, is hereby amended so that subsection 58-27 is hereby removed and that subsection 58-26 and 58-31 shall hereafter read as follows:

58-26: Parking of manufactured housing, mobile homes and travel trailers other than in mobile home parks prohibited:

Parking of manufactured housing, mobile homes and travel trailers, including but not limited to, camper buses, motor homes and camper trailers, for use as a permanent or temporary dwelling, outside of a mobile home park shall be prohibited

58-31: Location of HUD-code manufactured homes:

HUD-code manufactured homes shall be permitted in mobile home parks.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

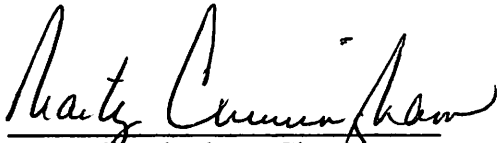
