

ORDINANCE NO. 03-33

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPOINTING A MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be appointing Demetra Robinson as Municipal Court Judge for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, said term will begin on December 17, 2003 and will end on December 17, 2005 at which time said term will be reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be appropriating funds in the amount of \$6,000.00 for the purpose of compensating this salary; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that Demetra Robinson be appointed as Municipal Court Judge and that there be appropriated \$6,000.00 to compensate for the Judge's salary; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

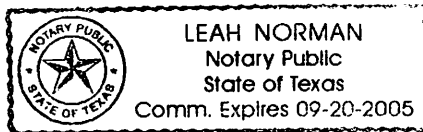
