

ORDINANCE 04-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE BE AMENDED BY REVISING THE TRAFFIC NO-PARKING MAP ADOPTED IN PARAGRAPH 3 OF SECTION 25-112 OF SAID CODE; AND BY AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP BY DESIGNATING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ALONG CERTAIN STREETS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Section I.

Whereas, the Traffic No-Parking Map is hereby amended to include the following No-Parking Area:

Designate a No-Parking Zone along the both sides of Washington Street from faculty parking lot to Charity Road ; Monday through Friday beginning at 7:25 am – 8:00 am and then again at 2:45 p.m. – 3:15 p.m.

Section II.

Whereas, the Traffic Control Map is hereby amended to include the following one-way traffic zone:

Designate the flow of traffic by creating a one-way traffic zone northbound on Washington from faculty parking lot to Charity Road ; Monday through Friday beginning at 7:25 am – 8:00 am and then again at 2:45 p.m. – 3:15 p.m.

Designate the flow of traffic by creating a one-way traffic zone on Abernathy Street from Charity Road to faculty parking lot; Monday through Friday beginning at 7:25 am – 8:00 am and then again at 2:45 p.m. – 3:15 p.m.

Section III:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$200.00.

Section IV:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

Section V:

If any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

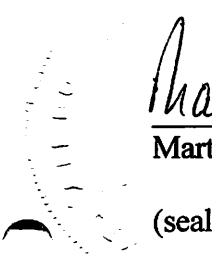
Section VI:

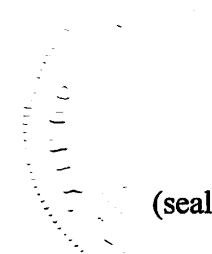

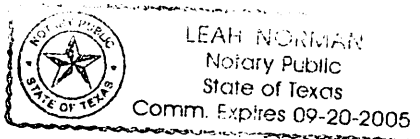
