

ORDINANCE 04-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING ARTICLE 1, SECTION 90-1, 90-7 AND 90-8 OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Sec. 90-1:

(a) Definitions.

As used in this article, the following words shall have the definitions ascribed to them by this section:

Jaywalking means to cross a street illegally or in a reckless manner.

Section 90-7 of the code of ordinances of the City of Commerce, Texas entitled "Disposition of fines and forfeitures" is hereby amended by renumbering said ordinance to Section. 90-8.

Section 90-7 of the code of ordinances of the City of Commerce, Texas shall become titled "Crosswalks" and shall read as follows:

This ordinance designating crosswalks within the City Limits of Commerce where there is a particular danger to pedestrians crossing the roadway or other places that is deemed necessary by city Staff. Said Ordinance will provide punishments for violations of this ordinance.

Pedestrians crossing a highway or street within the city limits of the City of Commerce must use a crosswalk if such crosswalk is provided.

Pedestrians crossing a street controlled by a traffic light must cross within the designated crosswalk only during the period in which the traffic signal facing them indicates that traffic in that direction has the right-of-way.

Penalty for crossing a street in any area other than within a designated crosswalk or for Jaywalking is punishable in the Commerce Municipal Court by a fine not to exceed \$200.00.

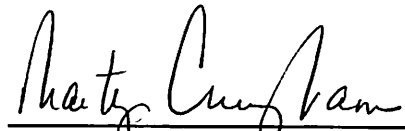
If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

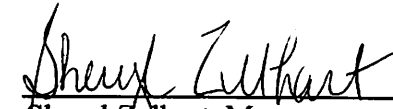

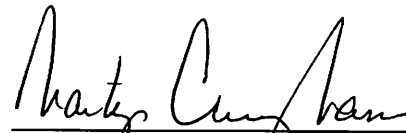
