

ORDINANCE NO. 06-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, AMENDING AND IMPLEMENTING STAGE TWO OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND DELCARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, Stage two of the Drought Contingency Plan was implemented on July 18, 2006;
and

WHEREAS, as a result of the drought conditions surrounding the City, the City council deems it to be in the best interest of the City of Commerce to amend Stage Two of the Drought Contingency Plan and implement said amendments, said amendments being attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" to said plan; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration the City Council of the City of Commerce does hereby amend Stage two of the Drought Contingency Plan and implement said amendments; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. The terms and provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be severable in that if any portion hereinabove described shall be held or declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the balance and remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.

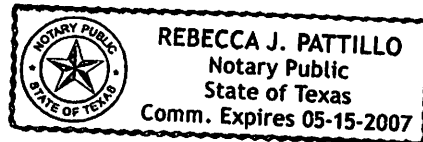

**COMMERCE FROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN
STAGE 2**

AMENDMENT #1

The City Council of the City of Commerce hereby amends the Drought Contingency Plan, Stage 2 on August 15, 2006 to read as follows:

Stage 2 Watering Restrictions

This only applies to hose end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems.

Saturday: Even numbered houses can water between 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. only.

Sunday: Odd numbered houses can water between 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. only.

These are the **ONLY** two days of the week that watering is allowed by hose end sprinklers or automatic irrigations systems.
