

ORDINANCE NO. 06-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE 2006-2007 TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE, PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the tax rate of \$100.00 valuation of the City of Commerce for tax year 2006-2007 is as follows:

.611769 for the purpose of maintenance and operation

.150680 for the payment of principal and interest on debt for this city

.762449 total tax rate

The tax collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of the City of Commerce, Texas, on this 28th day of September 2006, and was executed in duplicate.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public, all rules and regulation requiring the reading of said ordinance more than one time and on more than one occasion are hereby suspended.

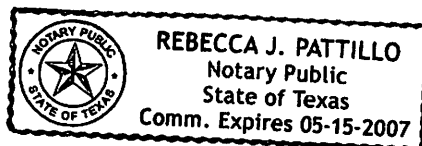
