

ORDINANCE 06-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING THE CITY OF COMMERCE ZONING ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Commerce hereby amends the zoning ordinance, Part III, Section 11-125 by changing the setback requirement for structures housing livestock from 100 feet to 50 feet.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

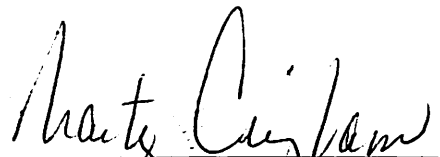
SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

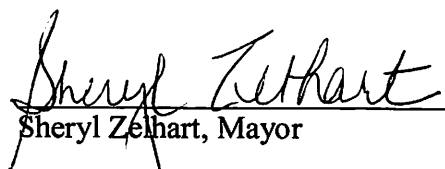

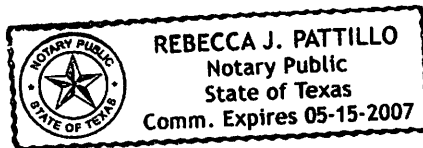
