

ORDINANCE 07-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 18-78 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

The City of Commerce hereby amends Chapter 18, Article IV, Section 18-78 of the Code of Ordinances by adding to Section 18-78, so as to read as follows:

Sec. 18-78; Rules and Regulations:

- (18) Recreational remote-controlled aircraft prohibited. For the safety of people, aircraft, and equipment, remote-controlled aircraft is prohibited.
- (19) General safety rules. Notwithstanding any other section of this article, no use may be made of land or water within any zone established by this article in such a manner as to:
 - a. Create electrical interference with navigational signals or radio communication between the airport and aircraft;
 - b. Make it difficult for pilots to distinguish between airport lights and others;
 - c. Result in glare in the eyes of pilots using the airport;
 - d. Create bird strike hazards; or
 - e. Otherwise in any way endanger or interfere with the landing, taking off, or maneuvering of aircraft intending to use the airport.

BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED this Ordinance shall be in effect after its initial passage and approval.

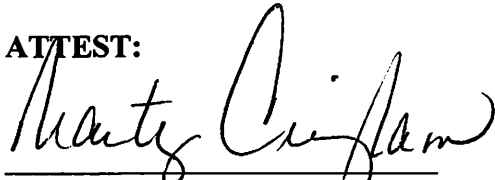
SECTION 1. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

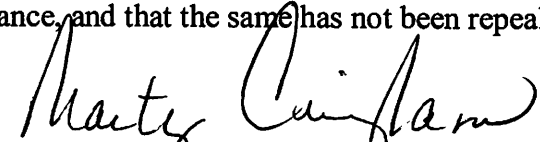

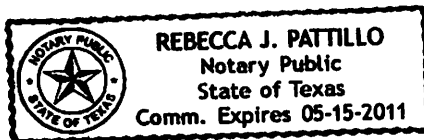

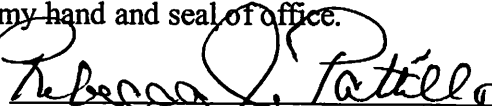
