

ORDINANCE NO. 08-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIRING A CITY MANAGER RECRUITING FIRM; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; DELCARING AN EMERGENCY AND CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce will be appropriating funds in the amount of \$24,500.00 into 140-6023 from Fund 01-15014; for the purpose of hiring a City Manager Recruiting Firm; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it in the best interest and general welfare of the City that there be appropriated \$24,500 into Fund 140-6023; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists necessitating the suspension of any rule requiring multiple readings of this Ordinance and all multiple readings of this Ordinance are hereby waived; this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

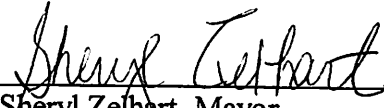
