

ORDINANCE 09-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING SECTION 66-60, OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

Section 66-60 entitled Enforcement, is hereby amended so that said subsection shall hereafter read as follows:

Section 66-60: Drilling or Mining Prohibited.

Drilling and/or mining for oil, gas or other minerals on city-owned public park property is hereby prohibited.

Section 66-61: Enforcement.

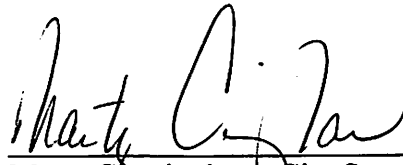
Compliance with the rules and regulations in this section is a condition of the use of the public parks and playgrounds of the city, and any person charged with the supervision and care of any park or playground and all police officers shall have authority to enforce the provisions of this section by expulsion from the grounds or issuance of citations.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

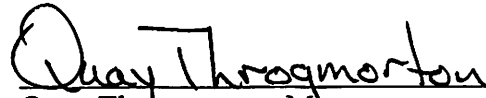
SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

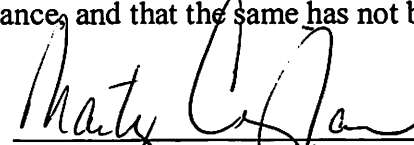

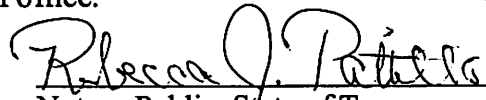
