

ORDINANCE 10-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING SECTION 10-210 OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE ZONING ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Commerce, after reviewing the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission, hereby amends Section 10-210 of the Zoning Ordinance.

Section 10-210 is hereby amended to include consignment shops in the schedule of uses.

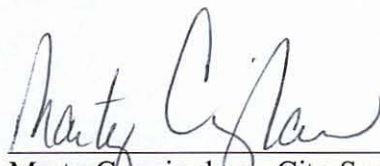

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

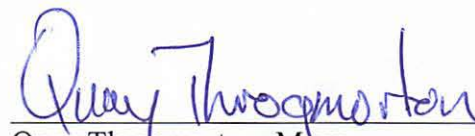
