

ORDINANCE 10-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE BE AMENDED BY REVISING THE TRAFFIC NO-PARKING MAP ADOPTED IN PARAGRAPH 3 OF SECTION 25-112 OF SAID CODE BY DESIGNATING NO PARKING ZONES ALONG HUNT STREET 146 FEET EAST OF WEST NEAL STREET CONTINUING 136 FEET FURTHER EAST; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Section I.

Whereas, that the Traffic No-Parking Map adopted in Paragraph 3 of Section 25-112 of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Commerce, Texas, be amended to include the following No-Parking Area:

Along Hunt Street 146 feet east of West Neal Street continuing 136 feet further east.

Section II:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$200.00.

Section III:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

Section IV:

If any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not effect the validity of this ordinance.

Section V:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

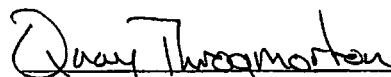

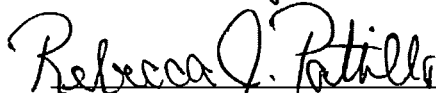
