

ORDINANCE NO. 10-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE 2010 CERTIFIED TAX ROLL FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE, PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The 2010 certified tax roll in the amount of \$286,754,106 is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

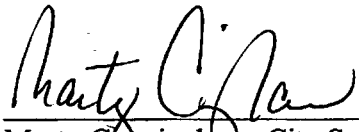
SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from now on after its passage and approval.

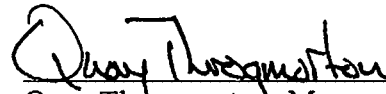

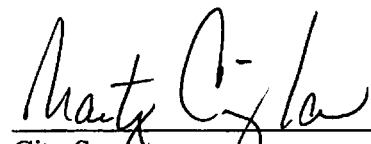

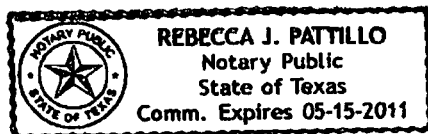
