

ORDINANCE 13-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, ADOPTING THE 2011 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AMENDMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND HEREBY DELCARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce, Texas is hereby amended by adopting the 2011 National Electrical Code with the North Central Texas Council of Governments Admendment;

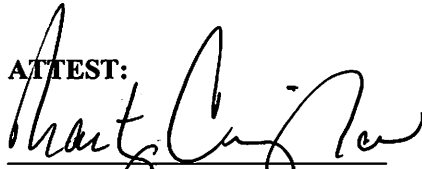

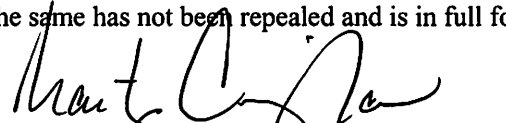
