

ORDINANCE 14-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE II, SECTION 10-107 OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES AND THE FEE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

The Code of Ordinance for the City of Commerce is hereby amended to include the following rates

Impound fees.....	\$5.00 per day
Pick Up Fees.....	\$5.00 per animal/per day
2 nd offense.....	\$25.00 per animal / per day
3 rd offense and each subsequent.....	\$45.00 per animal / per day
Animal License.....	\$No Charge
Impound of Livestock.....	\$10.00 per day
Quarantine Fees.....	\$10.00 per day/10days
Accepting Animal Inside City Limits.....	No Charge
Accepting Animal Outside City Limits in Hunt County.....	No Charge
Accepting Animal Outside Hunt County.....	\$45.00
Accepting Animals from other Organizations, Municipalities, Etc.....	\$45.00
Adoption Fee.....	Must pay all associated fees of Bringing animals shot records Current.
Female Dogs Spay	
• 3-50 Pounds.....	\$65.00
• Over 51 Pounds.....	\$75.00
Female Additional Charges determined by Veterinarian	
• In Heat.....	\$10.00
• Pregnant.....	\$25.00-\$50.00
Male Dogs Neuter	
• 3-50 Pounds.....	\$60.00
• Over 51 Pounds.....	\$75.00
Male Additional Charges determined by Veterinarian	
• Cryptorchid.....	\$25.00-\$50.00
Female Cats Spay	
• Spay.....	\$60.00

Female Additional Charges determined by Veterinarian

- In Heat.....\$10.00
- Pregnant.....\$25.00-\$50.00

Male Cats

- Neuter.....\$30.00
- Cryptorchid.....\$25.00-\$50.00

Rabies Vaccination – adopted animals.....\$10.00

Rabies Vaccination – in-pounded animals.....\$20.00

Pain medication is given at no additional costs.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

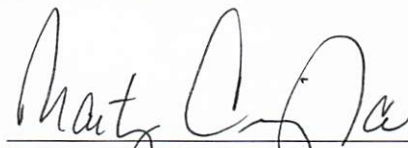

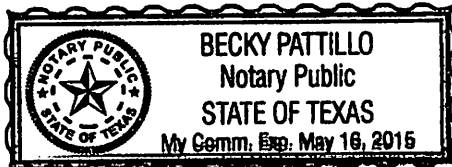
