

ORDINANCE 20 - 02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, IN HUNT COUNTY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE HERALD BANNER AS AN OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS UNTIL A TIME THAT A DIFFERENT NEWSPAPER IS SELECTED; GIVING THE CITY AND ITS DESIGNEE AUTHORITY TO PUBLISH IN THE NEWSPAPER AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 52.004 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that as soon as practicable after the beginning of each municipal year, the governing body of the municipality shall contract, as determined by Ordinance or Resolution, with a public newspaper of the municipality to be the municipality's official newspaper until another newspaper is selected; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce Journal and Herald Banner merged together in late 2019, and the Commerce Journal ceased printing and will become a part of the Herald Banner publication; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce desires to designate the Herald Banner as the official public newspaper of the City of Commerce;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Commerce designates the Herald Banner as the official newspaper of the City of Commerce, the same to continue as such until another is selected, and shall cause to be published therein all ordinances, notices and other matters required by law or by ordinance to be published.

SECTION 2. City Officials and/or designee are hereby authorized to publish required matters with the official newspaper of the City of Commerce.

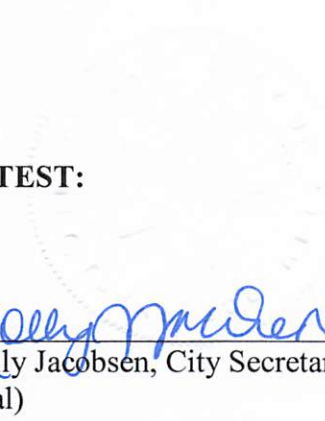
SECTION 3. Any and all Ordinances, Resolutions, and/or policies of the City of Commerce, Texas, whether written or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

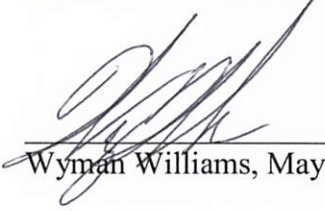

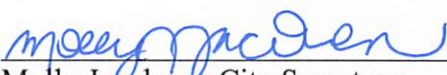
