

ORDINANCE 20 - 09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE II, OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 18-26(a), TITLED AIRPORT ADVISORY BOARD "CREATED, COMPOSITION; TERMS; APPOINTMENTS" ; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

The Code of Ordinance for the City of Commerce is hereby amended to revise the following section:

SEC. 18-26 Created; composition; terms; appointments

- a) There is hereby created the airport advisory board to be composed of seven members. Of which, at least 5 members shall be residents of the county and shall be appointed for two-year terms, and until their successors are appointed and qualified. Members of the airport advisory board shall be appointed by the mayor, with the advice and consent of the city council. Appointments to the advisory board shall be made at the first regular meeting after the annual election, or as soon thereafter as possible.
- b) The terms of three members shall expire in the odd-numbered years, and the terms of the other four members shall expire in the even-numbered years. Members shall be appointed to serve until the first regular meeting after the annual municipal election.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

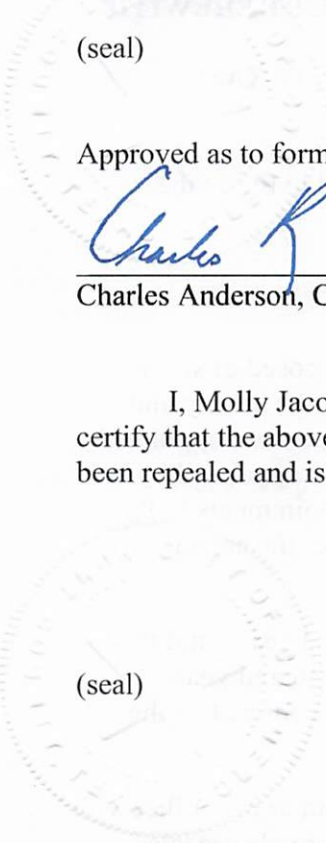
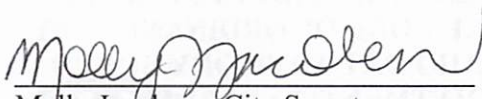
SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

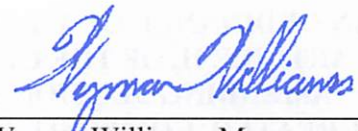

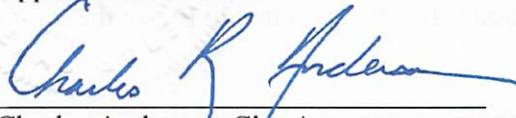

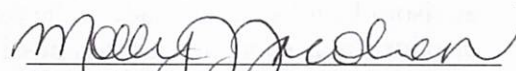
