

ORDINANCE 20 - 10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE VI, SECTION 10-138 OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 10-138, TITLED "ANIMAL CONTROL ORGANIZATION, ENFORCEMENT, AND PROTECTION" TO INCLUDE A SECTION REGARDING THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER'S AUTHORITY TO ISSUE CITATIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ARTICLE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

The Code of Ordinance for the City of Commerce is hereby amended to include the following changes, notated in red:

Sec. 10. – Animals.

Sec. 10-138. - Enforcement.

Enforcement of this article shall be the responsibility of an employee of the city, as directed by the City Manager.

The Animal Control Officer shall have the authority to issue citations for any violations of this article.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

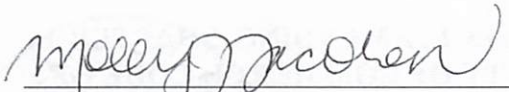
SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

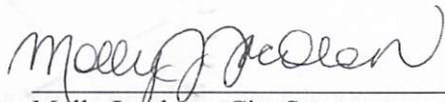
