

ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 12

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ADOPTING
THE 2020 - 2021 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, an annual, operating budget for the fiscal year which begins October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021 ("Fiscal Year 2021") has been duly created by the Interim City Manager Ned Muse and Finance Director Jamie Campbell of the City of Commerce with the input of the City Council and City Staff and in accordance with sections 102.002 and 102.003 of the Texas Local Government Code, and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director of the City of Commerce filed the proposed budget on August 1, 2020 in the Office of the City Secretary and made the proposed budget available for public inspection by taxpayers in accordance with section 102.005(b) of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce is of the opinion that the budget hereinafter set forth is proper and should be approved and adopted; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

The City of Commerce operating budget for the fiscal year October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, a true copy of which is attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim, be and is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 1. If any section, subsection, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from October 1, 2020.

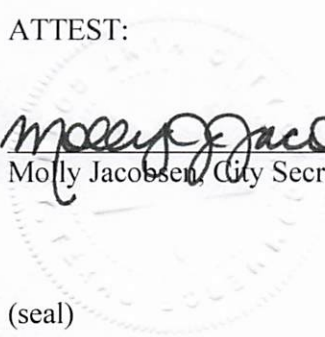

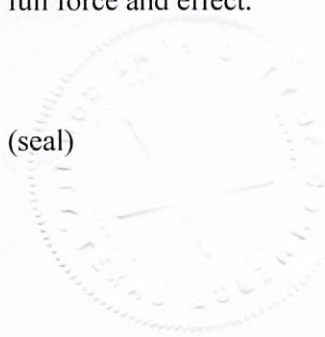
